Tendu by **Marc Sadler**. Two cables stretched between ceiling and floor define a vertical field where the diffuser slides, stops, and adjusts its orientation. No additional cables; the structure itself provides power. Tendu transforms tension into freedom. It positions itself where needed, rotates as required, and illuminates with precision.
